Order for Apportionment and Management under Local Government Act, 1894, s. 75 (2), including—

Vesting in Official Trustees of Charity Lands.



CHARITY COMMISSION.

In the Matter of the Charity of **THOMAS, LORD HOLMES**, in the Parish of **YARMOUTH** (Isle of Wight), in the County of **SOUTHAMPTON**, founded by Indenture of Bargain and Sale dated 28th January 1752;

In the Matter of “The Local Government Act, 1894”;
and

In the Matter of “The Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1894.”

The Board of Charity Commissioners for England and Wales, on the application of the Parish Council of the above-mentioned Parish, persons interested in the above-mentioned Charity:

And it appearing that the endowment of the Charity (consisting of the rentcharge specified in the Schedule hereto, and all other the endowment, if any, of the Charity) is held in part only for purposes of an ecclesiastical Charity:

13692. Wt. 4250.

Do hereby, in execution of the provisions of section 75 (2) of the Local Government Act, 1894, **Order** as follows :—

1. The following sums out of the yearly income of the Charity shall henceforth be a separate Ecclesiastical Charity to be called the Ecclesiastical Charity of Thomas, Lord Holmes :—

(a.) A yearly sum of 20s., being a sum sufficient on the average to provide for cleaning and repairing the Monument and Chapel in the Parish Church of Yarmouth aforesaid, erected in memory of Henry Holmes ;

(b.) One third part of the net residue of the said income applicable for the benefit of the Rector for the time being of the said Parish :

2. The remainder of the original Charity shall henceforth be called the Non-ecclesiastical Charity of Thomas, Lord Holmes :

3. The rentcharge specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby vested in "The Official Trustee of Charity Lands" for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the original Charity.
